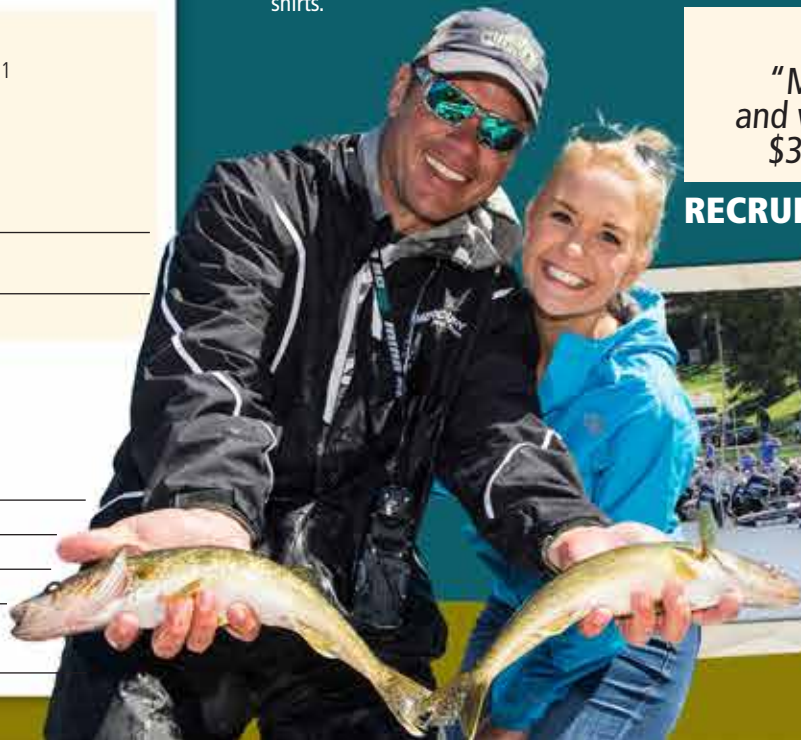

JUNE 3, 2017 TOURNAMENT RULES

I. PARTICIPANTS AND ELIGIBILITY

- Contestant must complete, sign and submit an official entry form along with the \$100 entry fee per team to Mn Adult & Teen Challenge, 2424 Business 371, Brainerd, MN 56401. Or, register online at mntc.org/events/fishingchallenge. Confirmations will be mailed or emailed.
- Contestants may pay with check, money order or credit card.
- This is a two-person per boat fishing tournament. If both contestants are under age 16, a non-fishing guardian or parent must be present.
- Contestants must attend the Friday, June 2, 2017 Rules Dinner at Heritage Assembly of God church in Baxter. Special fishing trips and other adult and youth contestant prizes will be awarded by draw at the rules meeting.
- Sponsorship funds (100 % tax deductible) raised to support Teen Challenge must be submitted prior to or at registration. Top fund-raisers win fishing trips with Al & Ron Lindner and Walleye Dan Eigen. The minimum amount requested that each team raise is \$500; there is no maximum.
- A very attractive raffle with tickets available to all teams makes fund-raising even easier.
- Contestants over 16 must possess a valid Minnesota fishing license.

II. SPONSORSHIP MATERIALS

- Teams are urged to begin the fund-raising process as soon as possible. Submit funds early! Teams may continue fund-raising up to tournament time, and submit additional contributions at registration.
- When you register online, an automatic online donation page will be created for your team. Call Rachael, 218-833-8764 for suggestions and assistance.
- A DVD will be part of each confirmation packet. Share the DVD with friends, church family, businesses, groups, etc., to enhance fund-raising and attract new teams.
- Envelopes will be provided when teams register. Funds should be sent to Mn Adult & Teen Challenge as they are raised.

III. SCORING

- Contestants may enter fish in bass, pike, walleye and panfish divisions.
- The "Mixed Bag" division may be entered, but excludes the team from entering the other divisions. "Mixed Bag" of one panfish, one walleye, one bass and one pike must be declared at weigh-in.
- In the panfish division, teams may weigh a maximum of three panfish (bluegill, sunfish, crappie or perch in any combination). Teams may weigh three walleyes in the walleye division. Teams may weigh three largemouth or smallmouth bass (in any combination) in the bass division. Teams may weigh only one northern pike in the pike division.
- One rock bass will be the bonus "kicker" fish and added to each division.
- Weigh-in headquarters: Cragun's Resort on Gull Lake.
- Ties will be settled by a coin toss.
- Plaques will be awarded for the largest dogfish, eelpout, sucker, carp and bullhead registered.

IV. TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- Tournament boundaries are the entire Gull Lake Chain.
- Launch at any ramp.
- Scales open at 1 p.m. Teams may weigh a limit for any species only once.
- Contestants may be on the water and at their fishing destinations, but may not begin fishing until 7 a.m.
- All boats must return to Cragun's Resort no later than 3 p.m.
- Teams returning earlier than the 3 p.m. deadline will streamline the weigh-in process.
- Artificial lures and live bait are allowed.
- Each competitor must observe safe boat conduct, no-wake zones, local navigation rules, demonstrate courtesy and act in a sportsmanlike manner.
- The tournament director will interpret rules according to the spirit and intent of the rule and his decision in all matters is final.
- All prizes and trophies will be awarded from the weigh-in stage immediately upon completion of the tournament. Winners must be present to collect prizes or they will be forfeited. Each team will be entitled to win one major prize; it will be for the highest finish of all divisions entered.

PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT

In exchange for being accepted into the Minnesota Fishing Challenge, I hereby release and discharge the tournament administrator, Lindner Media, Full Throttle Outdoors, Cragun's Resort, MN Adult & Teen Challenge and their officers, directors, agents, employees, volunteers, sponsors and legal representatives from the liabilities and/or injuries, damages, or loss sustained by me.

I expressly recognize that loss of property, injury or death could arise from 1.) the fishing and boating activities contemplated by the Event; 2.) the fact that competition rules contemplate that participants will fish in boats belonging to other participants as well as their own boats; 3.) the fact that the risks normally encountered in open-water fishing from a boat may be enhanced by the existence of competition.
