



2022 Fishing Challenge Student Angler Division Rules

- A student angler team consists of two anglers who are 18 or under and in school or graduated during the calendar year.
- Each team has one adult boat captain whose primary responsibility is operation of the boat and does not fish. The captain can net fish, but cannot handle them. Only the student anglers can fish and bring the fish to the weigh scale.
- The primary responsibility of the boat captain is safety. Boat captains will be responsible to know and understand the rules and ensure they are followed.
- Student anglers will compete in the tournament along with the main body of anglers. We will not be using an app to register fish. Student teams can enter any of the five divisions.
- Student anglers will bring their fish to the weigh-in and go through the prize tent if they finish in the top 10 of the division they enter.
- In addition, the top three student angler teams will be awarded a \$1,000 college scholarship from Sea Foam Sales Co., \$500 per team member. This award is given to the top three teams overall and is not limited to one division. (Example: we could have a 3rd place in bass, a 5th place in walleye, and a 7th place in panfish all winning scholarships.) Ties will be broken by the flip of a coin.
- The student angler entry fee is \$200 per team.
- Additional rules apply and are outlined in the rules of the Minnesota Fishing Challenge.
